Important: Sesh Space is privacy-first. Short retention and end-to-end encryption reduce what can be reviewed after content expires. Users should preserve screenshots for reports.

1. Respect for Intellectual Property

Sesh Space respects the intellectual property rights of creators, copyright owners, trademark owners, publicity rights holders, and other rights holders. Users may not post, share, transmit, advertise, or otherwise make available content that infringes another party's copyright, trademark, publicity rights, or other intellectual property rights.

2. Filing a Copyright Complaint

If you believe material on Sesh Space infringes your copyright, send a written notice to support@seshspace.com with sufficient detail for review. A proper notice should identify the copyrighted work claimed to be infringed, identify the allegedly infringing material with enough specificity for Sesh Space to locate it if still available, provide your contact information, include a statement of good-faith belief that the use is unauthorized, and include a statement made under penalty of perjury that the information in the notice is accurate and that you are the rights owner or authorized to act on the owner's behalf.

3. Temporary Content and Practical Limits

Because Sesh Space uses temporary retention and encrypted messaging, content may expire before a complaint is received or reviewed. If the complained-of content was posted in a feed, ad, listing, profile, SeshCircle, SeshTalk board, or shared in a private message, you should include screenshots and any other evidence showing the content, the username or business involved, and the relevant date and time. Sesh Space may not be able to retrieve content that has already expired or is not ordinarily accessible due to encryption.

4. Sponsored Content, Business Profiles, and Brand Use

Advertisements, company profiles, sponsored posts, merch references, business listings, and promotional materials must not use copyrighted works, trademarks, logos, images, celebrity likenesses, brand assets, or third-party content without permission. Advertisers and business users are responsible for ensuring they have all rights needed for submitted creative and promotional material.

5. Review and Action

When Sesh Space receives a sufficiently detailed complaint, it may investigate, remove or restrict access to content still available, notify the affected user where appropriate, reject or pause ads, restrict business accounts, and take additional enforcement action based on severity, repeat violations, or risk to the platform.

6. Counter-Notification

If content you posted is removed or restricted because of a copyright complaint and you believe the complaint was mistaken or that you had the right to use the material, you may submit a counter-notification. A valid counter-notification should identify the material, explain why you believe the removal was in error, include your contact information, and contain any legally required statements or consent-to-jurisdiction language applicable under governing law.

7. Repeat Infringer Policy

Sesh Space may suspend or terminate accounts associated with repeated intellectual property violations or abusive copyright complaints. A pattern of infringement, circumvention, re-uploading removed material, repeated infringing ads, or bad-faith notices may be grounds for escalated action.

8. Misuse of the Process

Knowingly making false or misleading copyright complaints or counter-notices may expose the sender to legal consequences and platform enforcement. Sesh Space reserves the right to disregard incomplete, abusive, or facially invalid notices.

9. Trademark and Other Rights

If your concern relates to trademark misuse, impersonation, false endorsement, brand confusion, business impersonation, or another non-copyright rights issue, include that clearly in your report with supporting documentation. Sesh Space may review such matters under these procedures or under its impersonation, fraud, advertising, and abuse rules.
