



# Sesh Space Privacy Policy

**Important:** Sesh Space is privacy-first. Short retention and end-to-end encryption reduce what can be reviewed after content expires. Users should preserve screenshots for reports.

## 1. Overview

Sesh Space is built around limited retention, minimal collection, and end-to-end encrypted messaging. This Privacy Policy explains what information Sesh Space needs to operate, what it does not use for behavioral advertising or profiling, how temporary content works, and the practical limits created by encryption and short data retention.

## 2. What Sesh Space Is Designed Not to Do

Sesh Space is not designed to run behavioral advertising profiles, track in-app behavior for marketing purposes, sell personal information, or retain message content as a standard business model. We do not use user activity to build interest graphs, ad audiences, or cross-site behavioral profiles. We do not read private message content in the ordinary course because private messages are end-to-end encrypted.

## 3. Information Necessary to Operate the Service

Even a privacy-first service requires limited operational data. Depending on how you use Sesh Space, this may include basic account identifiers such as email address, chosen display name or username, authentication-related records, encrypted storage pointers, device/session state needed to keep you signed in, profile information you choose to provide, optional location settings, push notification subscription records, abuse-prevention signals, report records, admin action logs, and limited system or security logs necessary to operate, secure, and troubleshoot the service. Sesh Space does not treat these operational necessities as a license to track user behavior for ads or profiling.

## 4. Information Sesh Space Does Not Collect as a Product Model

Sesh Space does not collect user activity for behavioral advertising analytics, does not sell personal information, does not maintain a behavioral dossier, and does not intentionally retain private message content in readable form. The platform's retention model is intentionally narrow: feed content is removed after approximately fourteen (14) days and private messages are removed after approximately twenty-four (24) hours, except where specific operational features or legal needs require limited separate records.

## 5. Encrypted Messages

Private messages are end-to-end encrypted. In ordinary operation, Sesh Space cannot read the content of those messages. This improves privacy but also means Sesh Space may be unable to retrieve message contents, recover

deleted content, or independently verify allegations about private message content after the fact. Users who need to preserve evidence for safety or enforcement reasons should take screenshots before content expires.

## 6. Feed Retention, Message Retention, and Exceptions

Feed posts are designed to expire automatically after approximately fourteen (14) days. Private messages are designed to expire automatically after approximately twenty-four (24) hours. While system backups, caches, or brief technical lag may occasionally delay full propagation of deletion, Sesh Space's intended design is short retention, not long-term storage. Once content is deleted or expires, it may be permanently unavailable.

Pinned posts, staff notices, moderation records, admin action logs, legal records, report metadata, account records, business listings, campaign records, suggestion records, and security records may be retained differently when reasonably needed to operate, document, protect, or comply with the service.

## 7. How Operational Information Is Used

Limited information is used only for essential service functions such as authentication, secure delivery, account management, profile display, optional push notifications, optional location features, abuse prevention, moderation, bug resolution, reliability, analytics that are configured for platform operation, and legal compliance. Sesh Space does not use personal information, private messages, or detailed behavioral histories to target ads, track interest categories, or monetize behavior profiles.

## 8. Advertising and Sponsored Content

Sesh Space may display limited sponsored content, including advertisements from dispensaries, brands, or other third parties. These advertisements are presented based on general factors such as location, availability, campaign configuration, listing context, or platform context, rather than behavioral tracking or user profiling.

Sesh Space does not use personal behavioral data, message content, or detailed user activity history to build advertising profiles or target users across services. Advertising on Sesh Space is designed to be contextual and privacy-conscious, not surveillance-based.

## 9. Ad Analytics and Company Accounts

Verified company or advertiser accounts may receive campaign-level information such as impressions, clicks, campaign status, date range, budget/spend fields if configured, and general performance statistics. These metrics are intended to measure campaign delivery and do not include private message content. Sesh Space should not expose personally identifiable behavioral profiles to advertisers.

## 10. Dispensary, Strain, and Third-Party Data Sources

Sesh Space may display dispensary listings, product-adjacent information, strain reference information, business profiles, or related data sourced from third-party providers, public datasets, user suggestions, staff review, or advertiser submissions. This information may include business names, addresses, contact details, website links, location coordinates, listing type, verification status, sponsored status, strain names, generalized THC/CBD reference ranges, effects, flavors, terpenes, and general uses.

Sesh Space does not guarantee the accuracy, completeness, legality, license status, product availability, or current status of third-party or user-submitted data. Users should independently verify business details, legal requirements, and product information.

## 11. Location-Based Features

Certain features, including SeshMap, nearby buds, dispensary listings, directions, and location-based sponsored placements, may use approximate or user-controlled location data. Location handling is designed to protect privacy: coordinates may be rounded, fuzzed, jittered, obfuscated, or displayed only as a general area; exact user location is not intended to be exposed to others; and location sharing is optional and user-controlled.

Location features are for convenience and discovery only. They may be inaccurate, delayed, incomplete, or unavailable and should not be used as a safety-critical tool or legal compliance guarantee.

## 12. Demo, Preview, and Invite Modes

Sesh Space may provide demo, preview, sales, social-media, auto-walkthrough, company, admin, support, or invite-link modes. These modes may use mock data and may be available without a standard user account. Demo modes are intended for demonstration, testing, investor, sales, support, or marketing purposes and may not reflect real user data. Analytics should not fire in demo mode where configured that way.

## 13. Push Notifications and Device Signals

If you enable push notifications, Sesh Space may store push subscription information and related delivery metadata needed to send notifications and troubleshoot delivery. Browser, device, operating system, and permission settings may affect whether notifications are delivered. Push notification data is used to operate the notification feature, not to build advertising profiles.

## 14. No Behavioral Advertising Model

Sesh Space does not build behavioral profiles, track users across apps or websites, use message content for ad targeting, sell personal data, or provide advertisers with private message content. Any advertising present on the platform is not based on personal surveillance or behavioral tracking systems.

## 15. Sharing and Disclosure

Sesh Space does not sell personal data. We may share limited information with infrastructure or service providers strictly as needed to operate the platform, including hosting, authentication, database, storage, email, push notification, analytics, payment or commerce providers if later used, and support tooling. We may also disclose information to legal authorities when required by valid legal process or when disclosure is necessary to prevent imminent harm, enforce policies, or protect the service. Because private messages are end-to-end encrypted, message content may not be available to disclose.

## 16. Safety, Reporting, and Evidence Preservation

If you are subjected to harassment, threats, bullying, illegal conduct, misleading ads, suspicious listings, or other policy violations, you should preserve evidence immediately. Because content is temporary and messages are encrypted, Sesh Space may not be able to retrieve content after it expires. Reports are strongest when they include screenshots, usernames, listing names, dates, times, and a description of the conduct.

## 17. Account Deletion and Data Removal

You may request account deletion subject to security, fraud prevention, unresolved abuse reviews, payment or legal obligations if any, and the technical limits of encrypted or already-deleted data. Due to the platform's design, some content may already be expired or irrecoverable when a request is made. Some limited records may be retained where reasonably necessary for enforcement, legal compliance, financial records, dispute handling, or service protection.

## 18. Children and Age Restrictions

Sesh Space is intended only for users who are at least twenty-one (21) years old. The service is not directed to children.

## 19. Regional and Legal Rights

Depending on your location, you may have rights relating to access, correction, deletion, portability, objection, restriction, or appeal under applicable law. Sesh Space will honor non-waivable legal rights that apply to users in their jurisdiction. Because the platform uses encryption and temporary retention, some rights may be limited by what data is still available and technically accessible.

## 20. Security Measures

Sesh Space uses reasonable technical and organizational measures designed to protect accounts and platform integrity, including access controls, transport security, Supabase Row-Level Security, staff access controls, logging, and end-to-end encryption for private messages. No service can promise absolute security, and users should also protect their own devices, credentials, screenshots, and recovery access.

## 21. Changes to This Policy

Sesh Space may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. Material updates will be reflected by a revised date and, where appropriate, presented through the service.
